Bio – Shubham Sharma

Shubham Sharma is a seasoned Indian domestic cricketer from Indore, Madhya Pradesh, born on 24 December 1993. A right-handed middle-order batsman — who can also contribute with occasional off-break bowling — Shubham has built a reputation over many years in red-ball and domestic circuit cricket. He made his first-class debut for Madhya Pradesh cricket team in November 2013 against Baroda. Since then, he has accumulated multiple centuries and consistent performances across formats, with his first-class record including 11 hundreds and many fifties. Shubham's game is characterized by patience and classical technique — ideal for longer formats. Even though he hasn't featured much in T20s or IPL, he remains a “red-ball warrior”: someone who values building innings, grinding out runs, and anchoring the batting under pressure. Off the bat, while batting is his primary asset, his off-spin and fielding add depth to his profile, making him a useful all-round contributor in domestic squads. If he were to take up a contract under an International Sportsperson Visa (for UK club / league cricket), Shubham could be a dependable top-/middle-order batsman offering solidity at the crease, occasional spin option, and experienced domestic-level temperament.
